

THE TERRITORY OF NAURU

No.6 of 1966

A N O R D I N A N C E

To make interim provision for the appropriation of moneys out of the public moneys of the Territory for certain expenditure in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven.

(Assented to ^{21 JUN 1966})

Be it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Nauru, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Nauru Act 1965, as follows:-

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supply Ordinance 1966-67.

Ordinary services.

2. There may be issued out of the Public moneys of the Territory and applied for the ordinary services of the Administration specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance in respect of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, the sum of Four hundred and twenty nine thousand dollars.

Capital services

3. There may be issued out of the Public moneys of the Territory and applied for the capital services specified in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance in respect of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, the sum of One hundred and eighteen thousand dollars.

Public moneys appropriated.

4. The Public moneys of the Territory are appropriated to the extent necessary for the purposes of the last two preceding sections.
