DECLARATION OF CONSTITUTION

In accordance with the terms of a Resolution passed by the Constitutional Convention for Nauru, established by the Constitutional Convention Ordinance 1967, I, as the Chairman of that Convention, declare that on the twenty-ninth day of January 1968 the Constitutional Convention did adopt, enact, and give to the people of Nauru The Constitution of Nauru and, in accordance with the words of enactment, which provided that the Constitution should come into force on the thirty - first day of January 1968, I further declare that The Constitution of Nauru has now come into force and is the supreme law of the Republic.

Declared by me this thirty-first day of January, 1968.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Agreement made on the twentysixth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixtyfive, between the Government of the Commonwealth of
Australia, the Government of New Zealand and the Government
of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern
Ireland the Nauru Act 1965 made provision for the
administration of Nauru:

AND WHEREAS the Nauru Independence Act 1967 provides that on the expiration of the day preceding Nauru Independence Day the Nauru Act 1965 is repealed and all Australian Acts that extend to Nauru as a Territory of the Commonwealth shall cease so to extend:

AND WHEREAS the Nauru Independence Act further provides that on and after Nauru Independence Day, Australia shall not exercise any powers of legislation, administration or jurisdiction in or over Nauru:

NOW THEREFORE I, Richard Gardiner, Baron Casey, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the

Federal Executive Council, hereby proclaim the thirtyfirst day of January, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight to be Nauru Independence Day.
