PROCLAMATION

By the Council of State for Nauru.

Ô

The Council of State, in pursuance of its powers under section 46 (g) of the <u>Customs Ordinance</u> 1921 of New Guinea, adopted as a law of the Republic,

- (a) revokes the proclamation made under that section by His Honour, the Acting Administrator of the Territory of Nauru, on the 24th day of May, 1965;
- (b) prohibits the important from New Zealand of pigs; and
- (c) prohibits the import from New Zealand of pigmeat, unless it is accompanied by a certificate from New Zealand government authorities verifying that it has been under deep freeze conditions for not less than 21 days before its export.
