NAURU LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL ORDINANCE 1951-1967

Every Nauruan over the age of 21 years is entitled to be enrolled as an elector for Nauru Local Government Council Elections unless he has been convicted <u>and</u> is under sentence, or is awaiting his sentence, for an offence punishable by imprisonment for not less than 12 months.

An elector who now lives in a District and whose name is on the electoral roll for another District may apply to have his name transferred to the electoral roll for the District where he now lives.

Any eligible person who is not yet enrolled or who wishes to have his name transferred should call at my office without delay so that the electoral rolls can be amended or corrected for the coming elections.
