Declaration of Elected Councillor

<u>Declaration of Elected Councillor</u>

Section 12 of the <u>Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance</u> 1951-1967 provides, inter alia, that there shall be one Councillor elected to represent the District of Boe.

There being only one candidate nominated to be elected as a Cuncillor for the District of Boe, namely Hammer DEROBURT, I, Kenneth Robert Sydney Miller, Returning Officer, acting in pursuance of section 22(3) of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1967, DO HEREBY DECLARE that candidate HAMMER DEROBURT is duly elected as the Councillor in the Nauru Local Government Council representing the District of Boe.
