DOG LICENCES

The attention of all dog owners is drawn to the provisions of the Licences Ordinance, Sections 12 to 17.

Registration of all dogs for the year 1968 is now overdue, and any person owning an unregistered dog is advised to effect registration immediately.

Any person owning an unregistered dog is liable to be fined, and dogs found at large may be impounded for a period of 7 days, after which time they may be destroyed.

Registration of dogs can be made at Police Headquarters Office. Fees are \$1.00 for a male dog and \$2.00 for a female dog per year.
