NAURU PUBLIC SERVICE

VACANCIES

Applications are invited from persons inside and outside the Public Service for employment in the following positions.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND EDUCATION

DIRECTOR OF MEDICAL SERVICES

DUTIES

Responsible to the Secretary for Health and Education for the Administration of the Government Hospital of 100 beds and for medical services, public health and quarantine control for the Republic.

QUALIFICATIONS

A qualified Medical Practitioner with good experience in medicine, surgery, obstetrics and particularly diagnosis. Diploma in tropical medicine, including leprosy control would be an advantage. It is preferable that he be competent in reading chest x-rays and have some background of tuberculosis treatment.

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY AND ISLAND DEVELOPMENT

DIRECTOR OF LANDS AND SURVEY

DUTIES

The successful applicant will be responsible to the Secretary for Industry and Island Development for planning and supervising the operations of the Survey Department which has a total staff of 14. He will be required to direct cadastral, engineering and detail surveys on the island and personally undertake more complex surveys and related computations. He will control the functions of the Drawing Office which include production of survey, engineering and feature plans, preparation of lease agreements, determination of encumbrances and boundaries and land registration. The Director will co-ordinate land usage and act as adviser on town planning and matters of land policy. In-service training and management of budget allocations will also fall within his duties.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A Licensed surveyor with at least five years practice since qualifying. Applicants should be experienced in the direction of field and office staff in a comprehensive range of survey work.

WORKS DEPARTMENTDIRECTOR OF WORKSDUTIES:

Responsible to the Secretary for Works, the Director will co-ordinate and supervise the operations of the Works Department which has a labour force of over 300, the majority of whom are Nauruans. He will be responsible for preparing the designs and specifications of a major housing project and will oversee the subsequent construction and maintenance thereof. In addition, the Director will have charge of the construction and maintenance of all Government properties, and sealed roads. He will be responsible for the Government Workshops, the island's water supply, garbage collection and a bus service of 12 vehicles.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Formal qualifications in Architecture or Civil Engineering would be preferred in that order but wide experience in these fields will be considered as an alternative. The person sought will have proven ability in building design and construction, including structural steel work, quantity surveying and estimating. Preferably he will also have a background of workshop management, being accustomed to the organization of carpentry, plumbing, electrical and mechanical services. Previous tropical experience will be an advantage.

TECHNICAL OFFICER - CIVIL ENGINEERING AND BUILDING.DUTIES

To provide general assistance to the Director of Works in the planning, co-ordination and management of new constructions, repairs and maintenance of Administration buildings, houses and civil undertakings on the island.

He will be required to prepare designs and specifications for construction of buildings of average complexity and quantity assessments for such works; assist in the general organization and control of the joinery and other sections of the department of Works associated with building construction and maintenance and perform on-the-job supervision of new works and maintenance projects. He will direct office and field labour forces, train direct labour force in connection with above duties, and provide administrative assistance to the Director of Works in the preparation of works projects and progress reports, orders for building materials and similar tasks.

QUALIFICATIONS

Sound knowledge of building construction and ability to prepare working drawings. Knowledge of taking of quantities and estimating would be an advantage. Administrative and organizing ability.

TECHNICAL OFFICER - MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICALDUTIES

To provide the Director of Works with assistance in planning, co-ordinating and managing the mechanical and electrical services of the Department of Works. The appointee will control the steel/sheet-metal, welding, plumbing and electrical sections of the Department's workshops and supervise the Administration transport facilities including the bus fleet. He will be responsible for the maintenance of heavy earth-moving equipment, pumping stations and water supply.

QUALIFICATIONS

Mechanical and Electrical experience together with administrative and organizing experience. A knowledge of refrigeration and small air-conditioners would be useful.
