PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 1961-1968

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 15 AND 17

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 38

WHEREAS Section 15(1) of the Public Service Act, 1961-1968, interpreted in accordance with Article 86 of the Constitution, provides (inter-alia) that the President may, by notice in the Gazette, create a new office, abolish an office or raise or lower the classification of an office:

AND WHEREAS Section 27(1) of the Public Service Act, 1961-1968, interpreted in accordance with Article 86 of the Constitution, provides that the President may, by notice in the Gazette, fix from time to time the scale of rates for salaries paid to officers.

AND WHEREAS Section 38 of the Public Service Act, 1961-1968, interpreted in accordance with Article 86 of the Constitution, provides that the President may, on the recommendation of the Commissioner, approve the payment to officers of special allowances at such rates as he determines.

AND WHEREAS it is now now desirable to abolish existing offices and create new ones and to fix new scales of rates for officers appointed to such positions:

AND WHEREAS by virtue of Article 21 of the Constitution the powers and functions of the President vest during his absence from Nauru in an Acting President appointed by Cabinet.

NOW THEREFORE I, AUSTIN BERNICKE the Acting President, aforesaid

- (1) hereby, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 15(1) of the Public Service Act, 1961-1968 revoke all previous offices created thereunder and notified in the Gazette except those offices designated Secretary of a Department or any office pertaining to the Melbourne or London Offices of the Republic.
- (2) hereby, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 15(1) aforesaid create the offices set-out in the first column in the first Schedule to this notice.
- (3) hereby, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 27(1) of the Public Service Act, 1961-1968, fix the scale of rates in the second column of the First Schedule aforesaid as appropriate to the offices appearing opposite thereto:
- (4) hereby, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 27(1) aforesaid fix the scale of rates applicable to the clerical/administrative positions in accordance with the Table set forth in the Second Schedule to this notice.
 - hereby determine under Section 38 of the Public Service Act, 1961-1968, that allowances shall be payable to officers and employees of the Public Service in accordance with the Table set forth in the Third Schedule to this notice, and

The Acting President has validated, under Section 38 of the Public Service Act, 1961-1968, the payment of the following allowances.

#### INDUCEMENT ALLOWANCE

#### CHIEF SECRETARY'S DEPATMENT

Payable to expatriate male and female officers, other than teachers who are paid under existing Determinations.

- (a) Officers of Secretary or Director level the sum of \$750 p.a. for married officers and the sum of \$400 for single officers.
- (b) For all other officers the sum of \$1,463
