- 4. All persons wishing to nominate candidates may collect nomination forms from the Deputy Electoral Registrar, Secretary for Justice's Office and lodge the same before noon on the 31st of July with the Returning Officer, the Acting Chief Secretary.
- 5. Candidates need only be nominated by two electors and it is requested that no more than one nomination paper for each candidate be lodged with the Returning Officer. Only the first valid nomination paper for each candidate will be accepted.
