NAURU LANDS COMMITTEE

In the matter of an application by <u>Minnie Eobob</u> and others to determine whether certain lands owned by <u>Mwareow Dowaiti</u> are held by him on trust for all cr any of the applicants.

WHEREAS on the 6th day of November, 1971, His Honour, Mr. Justice I.R. Thompson, Chief Justice, in the excercise of the Civil Jurisdiction of the Supreme Court of Nauru in Land Appeal No. 7 of 1970 between the above named parties, did state alia as follows:- ------

G.N. No. 311/1971 (cont'd)

"Their proper course is to take before the Nauru Lands Committee their dispute with Mwareow, alleging that he is bound to hold the lands as their trustee. The Neuru Lands Committee will then deal with the dispute, it being a dispute about the beneficial ownership of the lands. When the Nauru Lands Committee has done so, there will be a right of appeal to this Court within 21 days of that determination if either party wishes to avail himself of it".

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> the Nauru Lands Committee has been so requested to enquire whether or not the said MWAREOW DOWAITI holds any and if so what lands in trust for the above named applicants or any of them and has made full enquiry into the claims and heard all of the arguments and evidence adduced by the parties.

 $\frac{NOW}{The}$ the Nauru Lands Committee finds no evidence to substantiate the claims of the applicants or any of them and further finds that the said Mwareow Dowaiti is in respect of each of the following lands the beneficial owner in the shares stated in the respective gazette notices, that is to say:-
