NOTE

- 1. Voting is compulsory.
- 2. All Nauruans over 20 years living in Buada must be enrolled as electors before Saturday the 15th June, 1973.
- 3. All Nauruans who are on the rolls for Buada District and who live in another District <u>must</u> apply to have their names transferred to the roll of their new <u>District</u>. Failure to do so will render the elector liable to a \$6.00 fine.
- 4. The Rolls are held with the Deputy Electoral Registrar, and may be inspected at any time during Government Office hours in the office of the Senior Legal Officer.
- 5. Only Nauruans who are entitled to be electors for Buada (i.e., those who are properly enrolled as electors for Buada District) are qualified to be candidates for this election.
- 6. All persons wishing to nominate candidates may collect nomination forms from the Deputy Electoral Registrar (Senior Legal Officer's Office) and lodge the same before noon on the 23rd June, 1973 with the Returning Officer, who is the Acting Chief Secretary.
- 7. Candidates need only be nominated by two electors and it is requested that no more than one nomination paper for each candidate be lodged with the Returning Officer. Only the first valid nomination paper for each candidate will be accepted.
