AIR HOSTESSES

Applications are invited from young women willing to undergo training as Air Hostesses in Australia and Nauru with a view to employment by Air Nauru. At present twenty posts are available. Applications should be forwarded to the Public Service Commissioner, Administration Building Nauru to arrive not later than 4.30 p.m. on Friday, 12th March.

Applicants must:

a) the eighteen years of age and over

- b) be under nine stone in weight
- c) supply particulars of their educational standard and present or previous employment

Members of the Public Service are eligible to apply.

Acceptance for training as an Air Hostess does not in itself mean that applicants will be appointed to the Public Service. Those who complete the course successfully will however be eligible for employment by Air Nauru either on a permanent or temporary basis.

While undergoing training in Australia successful applicants will be provided with accommodation and a subsistence allowance. On appointment as Air Hostesses after completion of training they will be paid commencing salaries as follows:

\$1,968.00 p.a. - 18 years \$2,290.00 p.a. - 19 years \$2,945.00 p.a. - 20 years \$3,138.00 p.a. - Adult
