SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION

PURPOSE OF THE EXAMINATION

1. An examination will be conducted to provide a scholastic criterion on which to base the selection of students who seem best able to cope with and benefit from secondary studies overseas.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

- 2. Scholarships will be open to Nauruan children.
- 3. Up to ten Lower Age and up to ten Upper Age Scholarships will be awarded to students under 13 years 6 months and under 17 years of age respectively, as at 31st December 1976. Pupils in Form 2 who are over the 13 years 6 months age limit are not eligible to sit the examination.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

- 4. Selection will be based primarily on examination results. However, consideration will be given to the dandidates' school results and reports by school principals on such factors as attitude to work and relations with other pupils and staff.
- 5. Candidates will have to show that they have the necessary personal qualities as well as the essential intellectual and academic ability for study overseas.

THE SCOPE OF THE EXAMINATION

- 6. There will be four separate tests:
 - a) a standardised verbal Intelligence Test,
 - b) a standardised test in Mathematics,
 - c) a standardised test in Reading Comprehension,
 - d) a locally constructed objective test in English Language Usage and Expression.

DATE AND TIMING OF THE EXAMINATION

7. a) The examination will be held on Monday, 2nd August.

b) The Intelligence and Mathematics tests will be administered in a morning session. The Reading and English tests will be administered in an afternoon session.
