INSURANCE ACT 1974

INSURANCE (APPLICATION FOR LICENCE) REGULATIONS 1977

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on it by section 34 of the Insurance Act 1974, the Cabinet has made the following Regulations -

TITLE

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Insurance (Application for Licence) Regulations 1977.

APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE UNDER SECTION 31 OF THE ACT

2. (1) A person seeking to have a licence granted under Section 31 of the Act to a corporation incorporated, or intended to be incorporated, in Nauru or to a foreign corporation registered in Nauru under the Corporation Act 1972 for the corporation to carry on in Nauru the business of insuring risks outside Nauru or of reinsurance shall make application therefor in writing in the form set out in the Schedule to these Regulations and shall deliver or send the application to the Registrarof Banks of the Republic.

(2) Every such application as is referred to in the preceding paragraph shall be accompanied by a reference from an international bank in respect of every person who controls

INSURANCE ACT 1974

INSURANCE (INFORMATION) REGULATIONS 1977

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on it by Section 34 of the Insurance Act 1974, the Cabinet has made the following Regulations -

TITLE

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Insurance (Information) Regulations 1977.

AUDITED BALANCE SHEET, ETC., TO BE SUPPLIED TO THE REGISTRAR OF BANKS

2. (1) A corporation or foreign corporation to which a licence has been granted under Section 31 of the Act authorising it to carry on in Nauru the business of insurance of risks outside Nauru or of reinsurance shall, within six months after the end of every financial year of that corporation or foreign corporation occurring during the period of validity of the licence, supply to the Registrar of Banks of the Republic a copy of its audited balance sheet, its audited profit and loss account and its auditor's report in respect of that financial year.

(2) A corporation or foreign corporation to which such a licence as is referred to in the preceding paragraph is granted shall, forthwith upon the licence being granted to it, inform the Registrar of Banks in writing of the date on which its financial year ends.

(3) The Registrar of Banks shall transmit to the Minister, with such comments thereon as he thinks fit to make, all balance sheets, profit and loss accounts and auditor's reports supplied under this regulation and shall not reveal their contents to any person other than the Minister or permit any other person to have access to them.
