PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 1961-1975 PUBLIC SERVICE APPEALS BOARD ELECTION OF MEMBER

WHEREAS Article 70 of the Constitution provides for a Public Service Appeals Board consisting of the Chief Justice, one member appointed by Cabinet and one member elected by public officers

AND WHEREAS Section 81(1) of the Public Service Act 1961-1975 provides that the election of the member to be elected by contributors shall be conducted in such manner as the Cabinet, by notice in the Gazette, determines :

NOW the Cabinet hereby determines as follows :

- 1. John Shuttleworth shall be the Returning Officer and shall, subject to the directions of the Chief Secretary, make all necessary arrangements for the conduct of the election.
- 2. The Returning Officer shall prepare a list, Department by Department, of all persons who are or will be permanent officers of the Public Service on the date appointed for the election.
