STATUTORY SALARIES ACT 1974 JUDICIAL SALARIES REGULATIONS 1979

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on Cabinet by section 2 of the Statutory Salaries Act 1974 the Cabinet hereby makes the following Regulations -

TITLE

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Judicial Salaries Regulations 1979.

SALARY AND ALLOWANCES OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE

2. With effect from the 1st day of July 1978, the salary and allowances of the Chief Justice shall be those set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

REPEAL

3. The Judicial Salaries Regulations 1976 are hereby repealed.

SALARY AND ALLOWANCES OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE
