## SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIPS SCHEME FOR PRIVATE STUDENTS

Cabinet has approved the scheme for awarding special scholarships to private students who have successfully completed two years of secondary study overseas as a private student. Awards will be limited to students attending residential schools in Australia and New Zealand and who, while overseas, have achieved results of high order, above the average for their respective classes.

There will be two categories of special scholarships:-

- a) A special half scholarship awarded after completion of two years study overseas will provide -
  - half the school fees for tuition, board and lodging, text books and other compulsory fees;
  - the cost of approved medical, optical, hospital and dental expenses.

There will be no allowance for clothing or to offset vacation and long weekend expenses.

b) A special full scholarship awarded after the successful completion of Year 10 (Form 5 in N.Z.).

In such cases, results at Year 10 must strongly indicate that the student will gain Matriculation (University Entrance).

Such a scholarship will provide the same entitlements as normal scholarship students. These include:-

- one return fare per year;
- all compulsory school fees;
- a clothing allowance;
- 4. board and lodging and travel to central points during long weekends and vacations during the vear:
- cost of necessary classroom stationery;
- 6. approved medical, hospital, optical and dental expenses.

It is necessary that an application for a special scholarship be in writing. If not already held by the Department, a copy of all school reports over the preceding two years must be produced.

Applications should be lodged with the Director of Education as early as possible in December.

Action should be taken by the sponsor of a student on behalf of whom an application is made to ensure that the child is enrolled for the following year and that a re-entry visa is obtained. Generally, students awarded special scholarships will be expected to continue at the schools at which previously enrolled. In case any student wants to change the school, the sponsor should obtain from the school to be attended a letter stating that the student will be accepted giving the class to which he will be enrolled and if boarding house facility will be provided.

The awarding of such scholarships and the extent of the award will be at the discretion of the Minister for Health and Education.
