## BY-ELECTION - ANABAR CONSTITUENCY

Intending Candidates for By-Election to represent Anabar Constituency as member of the Parliament of Nauru are advised that :-

- (a) Nominations can only validly be made <u>after</u> the Rolls have been closed for each District in the Constituency (i.e. after Saturday the 5th February 1983) and on or before Nomination Day (i.e. on or before Saturday 19th February, 1983).
- (b) Nomination Papers may be handed to me at the Chief Secretary's Office during Public Service Office hours, Monday to Friday 7th February to 18th February 1983 inclusive. To assist intending candidates I will also be available in the Chief Secretary's Office between 8.00 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturday 19th February 1983 as nominations will close at 12 noon on that day.
