CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

#### ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE BUSINESS

OF GOVERNMENT

<u>IN EXERCISE</u> of the powers in that behalf vested in His Excellency the President, under Article 23 of the Constitution of Nauru, I, <u>HAMMER DEROBURT</u>, President of the Republic of Nauru, hereby assign to the Ministers of the Cabinet of Nauru, set out below, the responsibilities for the business of the Government of Nauru as set out opposite their names:-

MINISTER OF CABINET

Minister for Finance

### BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT

Minister for Works and Community Services

The Portfolio of the President, External and Internal Affairs, the Public Service in relation to the business of Government to be undertaken in Nauru by the said Minister.

The Portfolio of the Minister for Island Development and Industry in relation to the business of Government to be undertaken in Nauru by the said Minister.

The assignment of business of Government of Nauru as set out above is in addition to and not in substitution for the business of Government of Nauru already assigned to the said Ministers. The above assignments of responsibility for the business of Government shall be effective during the absence from the Republic of His Excellency President Hammer DeRoburt, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., M.P.

# SECTION 15(2)

#### NOTIFICATION OF DATE OF CLOSING OF ELECTORAL ROLL

#### AND NOMINATION DAY
