REPUBLIC OF NAURU COMMISSION OF INQUIRY PUBLIC NOTICE

A Commission of inquiry under the Commissions of Inquiry Ordinance 1948-1967 (Nauru) is to be held into the rehabilitation of the worked-out Phosphate Lands in the Republic of Nauru.

The Commission (Professor C.G. Weeramantry, Chairman, Mr. R.H. Challen and Mr. G. Degidoa) will conduct public hearings under the terms and reference into the question of responsibility for rehabilitation of Lands Mined before Nauruan Independence, and the feasibility of rehabilitation of all mined out lands on the island.

The Commission will open the hearings on Nauru on Monday February 23 1987, in the Supreme Court. Later hearing will be conducted in Melbourne (Australia) at Nauru House, 80 Collins Street, Melbourne, in Nauru and elsewhere as the Commission determines. It is anticipated that the Melbourne Hearings will commence in July 1987.

Members of the Public, Institutions and Governments are invited to make submissions to the Commission. Such submissions may be oral or in writing.
