ELECTORAL ACT 1965-1973

SECTION 12

IT IS NOTIFIED for general information that a Parliamentary By-Election will be held on Saturday, 2nd March, 1991.

Voting is compulsory for all electors, unless as elector:-

- 1. is absent from Nauru on polling day;
- 2. is seriously ill or infirm to the extent that he/she is precluded from attending at a polling place to vote;
- 3. (In the case of a woman) is precluded by approaching maternity from attending at a polling place to vote; or
- 4. has some other valid and sufficient reason for not voting (to the satisfaction of the Returning Officer).
