STATEMENT BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE PRESIDENT

The 15th of August is a day of commemoration marking the end of World War II in 1945. It is a day of significance particularly for the Pacific where the final battles were fought and sacrifices made. Nauru joins with all other Pacific countries in remembering this day and I accordingly, pursuant to the powers in that behalf vested in me under Section 44, subsection (4) of the Public Service Act 1961-1979, do hereby declare part of Tuesday, 15th August, 1995 from 12:00 noon till 4:42 p.m. to be a special holiday to be observed by the officers and employees of the Public Service to commemorate this event.
