AIR NAVIGATION ACT 1971 AIR NAVIGATION (AIRPORT FEE) REGULATIONS 1999

In Exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 35(1) of the Air Navigation Act 1971, the Cabinet has made the following Regulations –

SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Airport Fee) Regulations 1999 and shall come into operation on the first day of July, 1999.

INTERPRETATION

- 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires "Director" means the Director of Civil Aviation; "transit passenger" means a person who
 - (a) arrives in Nauru on an aircraft; and
 - (b) does not complete immigration formalities to enter Nauru; and
 - (c) does not leave the restricted area of the airport into which he arrives except to continue his onward journey.

AIRPORT FEES

3. Subject to the exemptions in Regulation 4, every passenger departing from Nauron an aircraft shall pay, before boarding the aircraft, an airport fee of \$25.00.

EXEMPTION

- 4. The following persons shall be exempt from the payment of the airport fee imposed by these Regulations:-
 - (a) a transit passenger;
 - (b) an aircrew member operating the aircraft departing from Nauru, or travelling on the aircraft in the course of his employee for the purposes of operating an aircraft;
 - (c) a child under the age of 12 year;
 - (d) such other persons as the Minister may from time to time by order in writing specify.

COLLECTION OF AIRPORT FEES

5. The Director shall be responsible for collecting the airport fee from a departing passenger, and for the purpose may, in writing, authorise a public officer to perform the collection.

REMITTANCE AND RETURN OF AIRPORT FEES

- 6. (1) The Director shall maintain in respect of each departing flight a record of
 - (a) all airport fees collected under these Regulations; and
 - (b) all exemptions from payment of an airport fee under regulation 4(c) and (d).
 - (2) As soon as practicable after each departing flight, the Director shall remit to the Treasury the total amount airport fees collected in respect of that flight, together with the records of the collections and exemptions from payment under subregulation (1).
 - (3) The airport fees received by the Treasury under sub-regulation (2) shall be paid into the Treasury Fund.

REPEAL OF AIR NAVIGATION (DEPARTURE FEE) REGULATIONS 1983

7. The Air Navigation (Departure-Fee) Regulations 1983 are repealed.
