First Schedule

In Exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 35(1) of the Air Navigation Act 1971, the Cabinet has made the following Regulations-

SHORT TITLE

1. These regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations 1999.

INTERPRETATION

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-

"aircraft mass" means the maximum authorised takeoff weight of an aircraft;

"Nauru Flight Information Region" means the area established by the Republic, endorsed by the International Civil Aviation Organisation, and accepted by the international aviation community to be the Flight Information Region for the Republic of Nauru.

AIF. NAVIGATION FEES

3. The owner or operator of an aircraft flying through the Nauru Flight Information Kegion shall pay an air navigation fee in accordance with the First Schedule.

AIRCRAFT LANDING FEES

4. (1) The owner or operator of an aircraft landing at the Nauru International Airport shall pay à landing fee in accordance with the First Schedule.

AIRCRAFT PARKING FEES

5. The owner or operator of an aircraft which is parked at the Nauru International Airport shall pay a parking fee in accordance with the First Schedule.

EXEMPTIONS

6. The Minister may with the approval of the Cabinet, by notice in writing, exempt an aircraft from the payment of all or any fees under regulation 3, 4 or 5, either generally or in respect of any specific flight or flights, landing or landings, or parking period or periods, as the case may be.

TERMINAL USE FEES

7. The tenant of space in the terminal building of the Nauru International Airport shall be charged a rental fee in accordance with the First Schedule.

REPEAL AND SAVING

8. (1) The Air Navigation (Fees and Charges) Regulations 1991 are repealed.

(2) Any fee payable under the Regulations repealed by subregulation (1) shall continue to be payable, and any action for the recovery of that fee may be taken or continued by the Republic or the Authority, in accordance with those Regulations as if they were still in force.
