GENERAL PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION 2000

ELECTORAL ACT 1965 - 1992 (SECTION 12)

IT IS NOTIFIED for general information that a General Parliamentary Election will be held on Saturday 8th April, 2000.

Voting is compulsory for all electors, unless an elector -

- 1. is absent from Nauru on polling day;
- 2. is seriously ill or infirm to the extent that he/she is precluded from attending a polling lplace to vote;
- 3. (in the case of a woman) is precluded by approaching maternity from attending at a polling place to vote; or
- 4. has some other valid and sufficient reason for not voting (to the satisfaction of the Returning Officer).
