MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICE FOR PETROL: PRICE CONTROL BOARD <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

It is notified for general information that cabinet approved the recommendation as follow:

- 1. Endorse the recommendation of the Price Control Board that a maximum retail price for petrol be set at a level 30 cents higher than the wholesale price at which petrol is sold by the Bank of Nauru.
- 2. Note that this maximum retail price will formally come into effect two weeks following the publication in the Government Gazette of official note of the Price Control Board determination.
- 3. Note that the Department of Finance will conduct regular surveys of petrol and diesel prices available at bowsers and will publicise the results on media.
- 4. Endorse the Board recommendation that a temporary rationing system be introduced for petrol whereby no bowsers will be permitted to sell more than 4 litres to an individual customer each day, with this rationing system to cease as soon as new delivery of petrol is made to the island.
