Applications are invited from Nauruans inside and outside the Public Service for appointment transfer of promotion to the following position:

POSITION: AUDITOR SALARY: \$6,670 pa (5.3)

PRIMARY PURPOSE OF POSITION:

The Auditor will be a member of an Audit team responsible to the Director of Audit for the audits of several Government or Semi-Government organizations, some of a Commercial character. The work will be varied and interesting. The Auditor will also be responsible for carrying out the work relating to the day to day administration of the department and preparation of the budget estimates etc.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Audit of the accounts of the Republic and its instrumentalities;
- Audit of the Records and Books of Accounts of Revenue, Expenditure, Store and Inventory, etc., maintain by all the departments of the Republic and its instrumentalities;
- Audit of the Accounts Books and Records of any other authority as directed by Director of Audit or Senior Auditors as head of Audit in accordance with the Audit Act 1973;
- Correspond and liaise with line agencies, public service departments, or ministries on any matters of the department;
- Compilation, tracking and registration of all Audit records;
- Maintain database on audit work;
- Compilation and formulation of monthly reports or annual reports;
- Prepare and maintain the Audit's budget quota for the financial year;
- Maintain records on department stock-take of inventory of government assets, i.e. office plant & equipment, furniture and stationeries;
- Treat all matters arising with due process and diligence, and utmost confidentiality;
- Perform any other duties as required by the Director of Audit.

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QUALIFICATION & EXPERIENCE:

- Minimum of year 12 education;
- Must have a professional accountancy qualification of a recognized association of Accountant/Department Accountancy qualification in a Government department;
