- Conduct a full review of all existing climate change related assessments, strategies/plans and produce recommendations for improved action and policy reviews [in coordination with Climate Change Officer];
- Develop and implement a National Climate proofing strategy;
- Coordinate with other unit sectors in developing a National Action Plan for water conservation, preservation of marine ecosystems, and protection of coastal areas;
- Undertake full responsibility of NauruClim program (comprehensive Climate Change scenario generator software valued at \$33k) as primary operator;
- Incorporate findings of scenario projections to address food security issues specifically taking into account the scientific characteristics of climate change (such as precipitation change, temperature change, sea level rise, and other meteorological data) [in collaboration with Agriculture/Quarantine/ROC Taiwan ICDF/ARMS];
- Undertake primary responsibility of sourcing funding [in collaboration with AMU] and *implementing* the Nauru Adaptation Programme of Action (Nauru Adaptation Plan of Action-NAPA aka 'RONADAPT'). All components within the NAPA are to be coordinated by the Adaptation Officer and its elements integrated into other existing mechanisms/programs.

QUALIFICATION & EXPERIENCE:

- A minimum of tertiary/graduate qualifications in (or relating) to Environmental Science is preferred;
- Demonstrated experience working with an Environmental organization will be an advantage;
- Demonstrated sound knowledge and understanding of the operations of international/regional environmental organizations and conventions surrounding climate change issues;

Position: Climate Change Officer

PRIMARY PURPOSE:

The Climate Change Officer is to oversee and coordinate the overall functions of the Mitigation and Adaptation activities within Environment Division of the Department of Commerce, Industry & Environment. The Climate Change Officer is essentially expected to provide guidance in policy making decisions and carry out implementation of activities based on the latest scientific data and technology available.

KEY RESPONSIBLITIES:

- Ensure that all Climate Change activity in Nauru is aligned to achieve targets for national priorities (NSDS) and MDGs;
- Coordinate and supervise implementation of both Adaptation and Mitigation activities incountry;
- Develop Climate Change related project proposals (in coordination with AMU and other relevant Government departments) for donor partners consideration;
- Provide recommendations based on Climate Change scenario projections for Government's consideration in future decision making processes or as required;
- Organize/Facilitate Climate Change capacity building in-country programs;
- Provide technical advise and scientific to PM to UN under umbrella of AOSIS

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Promote Climate Change Public awareness & Education (in collaboration with educational institutes, NGOs, church groups and community committees etc);
- Improve Climate Change scientific research and observation (in coordination with ARMS, DCA, BOM, IPCC, IGCI, NCSP, NDRMO, etc..)
- Cooperate with other external projects and entities in the implementation of CC related activities (eg. NRC, RONPHOS, PACC, NatComs, IWRM, SLM, SGP, NBSAP, Climate Change-Health WG, etc...)
- Produce recommendations and follow through in development of Climate Change policies (either new policies or as regulations introduced in the review of existing laws as needed:;
- Assist in the development and maintenance of Climate Change funding either nationally generated or through international mechanisms;
- Establish and maintain a centralized archive for all Climate Change related info data to be easily accessible by all Public Service Departments/SOEs (to be done in consultation with ICT);

- Establish a national mechanism which addresses the need to link synergies under the 3 Rio Conventions (UNFCCC/UNCCD/UNCBD) (Nauru is a signatory and has ratified all 3 conventions)
- Develop a national Climate Change framework to strengthen linkages using a cross-sectoral approach (regional initiatives such as PIFACC to be considered in process);
- Track, report and provide recommendations on Climate Change negotiations (in liaison with DFAT/PM to UN office in NY/AOSIS) (participation at UNFCCC negotiations is subject to Government's accredited nomination for each meeting);

QUALIFICATION:

- Equivalent qualifications to a Certificate of proficiency or higher in either Vulnerability & Adaptation or Climate Change Mitigation studies at post-graduate level;
- Minimum of 5 years work experience in Climate Change duties stationed in a single country;
- Required to have at least 3 years involvement at international negotiations conducted at the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change;
- Must have at least 2 years experience of involvement within any Environmental institute or organization other than the one employed in;
- Certified computer skills for word documenting, excel spreadsheet processing, and powerpoint presentations are necessary;
- Must have a broad understanding and knowledge of the operations and functions of climate change and environmentally related institutes within the region and internationally.

Duties:

- Review and update all national feasibility studies, assessments and documents that potentially relate to CC Mitigation
- Review the Master Land Use Plan and incorporate Climate Change Mitigation into the Reforestation activities. Estimates of emission offsets are to be calculated and provided for national records comparisons against neighbouring countries within the region and other major international emitters such as Australia, NZ, USA, China, India etc. (In cooperation with NRC and CCO);
- Develop an official carbon trading study document specifically for the Republic of Nauru, and provide advice to Government on a timely basis with regards to current international activity in the carbon market and feasible opportunities for Nauru if any;
- Review, improve and maintain existing National Greenhouse Gas inventories (In coordination with CCO);
- Implement objectives of the National Energy Policy Framework and maintain calculations of the carbon emission reduction amounts against fossil fuel consumption (In collaboration with NUA and DPPD);
- Develop and implement a National Climate Change Mitigation Strategy (In consultation with CCO, NUA, NRC, RONPHOS, etc..)
- Source funding obtains Mitigation Assessment software (eg. GACMO, MARKAL, LEAP, WASP etc...) tool and utilize to execute national calculations and generate scenario projections for economic development through use of Renewable Energy and provide recommendations accordingly for the NSDS and other related strategies. The Mitigation Officer will have full responsibility of the software program and undertake role as primary operator (In coordination with AMU);
- Conduct reviews of existing laws and provide recommendations for the introduction of new policies or amendments to current acts in relation to national Climate Change Mitigation requirements if necessary;
- Assist in the development and maintenance of a 'CC levy/fee' for incoming passengers on international flights and ferries, monitor progress and submit further recommendations to CCO as needed.
- Improved access to technology transfer for Climate Change Mitigation applicable to national circumstances;
