- 1. Police officers performing a role assigned the rostered operations or operations working pattern will be paid a Night Shift allowance of \$20.00 and \$25.00 respectively for each shift work performed between the hours of 000-0800 (12.00 midnight 0800 hours)
- On-Call & Recall allowance as follows:
 \$20 Monday Friday
 \$25 Saturday Sunday and Public Holidays
- 3. Risk Allowance:

All police officers irrespective of rank will be paid a risk allowance component of \$50 across the board per fortnightly pay in additional to shift allowance. This should be reflected separately in their pay slip during every pay cycle.
