PURSUANT TO the powers in that behalf vested in me under Section 81, subsection 1,2 & 3 of the Public Service Act 2016, the following days shall be observed by the officers and employees of the Public Service as Public Holidays for the year 2022.

Friday 15 <sup>th</sup> April, 2022	Good Friday
Monday 18 <sup>th</sup> April, 2022	Easter Monday
Tuesday 19 <sup>th</sup> April, 2022	Easter Tuesday
Tuesday 17 <sup>th</sup> May, 2022	Constitution Day
Friday 1 <sup>st</sup> July, 2022	RONPHOS Handover
Friday 19 <sup>th</sup> August, 2022	Ibumin Earoeni Day
Sunday 25 <sup>th</sup> September 2022	Hammer DeRoburt Day
Wednesday 26 <sup>th</sup> October, 2022	Angam Day
Sunday 25 <sup>th</sup> December, 2022	Christmas Day
Monday 26 <sup>th</sup> December, 2022	Day following Christmas

Whenever a day specified in subsection (1) except Independence Day and Christmas Day, falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday is a holiday.

Whenever Independence Day and Christmas Day, falls on Saturday or a Sunday the following Monday and Tuesday are holidays.
