## REPUBLIC OF NAURU PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 2016 SUBDIVISION 10, SECTION 1,2 AND 3

### PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2024

PURSUANT TO the powers in that behalf vested in me under Section 81, subsection 1,2 & 3 of the Public Service Act 2016, the following days shall be observed officers and employees of the Public Service as Public Holidays for the year 2024.

Thursday 1 <sup>st</sup> February, 2024	Day following Independence Day
Friday 8 <sup>th</sup> March 2024	International Womens Day
Friday 29th March, 2024	Good Friday
Monday 1st April, 2024	Easter Monday
Tuesday 2 <sup>nd</sup> April, 2024	Easter Tuesday
Friday 17 <sup>th</sup> May, 2024	Constitution Day
Monday 1 <sup>st</sup> July, 2024	RONPHOS Handover
Monday 19th August, 2024	Ibumin Earoeni Day
Wednesday 25 <sup>th</sup> September, 2024	Sir Hammer DeRoburt Day
Saturday 26 <sup>th</sup> October, 2024	Angam Day
Wednesday 25 <sup>th</sup> December, 2024	Christmas Day
Thursday 26 <sup>th</sup> December, 2024	Day following Christmas

Whenever a day specified in subsection (1) except Independence Day and Christmas Day, falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday is a holiday.

Whenever Independence Day and Christmas Day, falls on Saturday or a Sunday the following Monday and Tuesday are holidays.
