## AN ORDINANCE

*To Grant and Apply a Sum out of the Revenues of the Territory to the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and to appropriate the Supplies already Granted for such Year.*

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the “*Appropriation Ordinance, 1917-1918.*” Short title.

**2.** The Treasurer may issue out of the Revenues of the Territory and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen the sum of Eighty-four Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-six Pounds. Issue and application, £84,936.

**3.** In addition to the sum of Twenty-four Thousand Pounds granted by the *Supply Ordinances, 1916-1917, (Nos. 1 and 2)*, all sums granted by the last preceding section of Appropriation of supplies, £108,936

this Ordinance out of the revenues of the Territory towards making good the supply granted His Majesty amounting in the aggregate to the sum of One Hundred and Eight Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-six Pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to be appropriated as from the 1st day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen for the purposes and services expressed in the First Schedule.

Advances for the purposes of the Second Schedule.

4. In addition to the sums specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Appropriation of Loan and Grant Funds.

5. The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan and Grant Funds of the Territory towards the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, the sums mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto for the purposes specified therein.

Passed in Council this nineteenth day of September, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine and hundred and seventeen.
