B^E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri- Preamble. tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :---

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation short title. Ordinance, 1926-1927.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Revenues of Issue and application, the Territory and apply towards making good the supply #186,1875. hereby granted to His Majesty for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven the sum of One Hundred and Eighty-six Thousand One Hundred and Eighty-seven Pounds Ten Shillings.

Appropriation Ordinance, 1926-1927.

Appropriation of supplies, £186,187¹/₂. **3.** All sums granted by the last preceding section of this Ordinance out of the Revenues of the Territory towards making good the supply granted His Majesty amounting to the sum of One Hundred and Eighty-six Thousand One Hundred and Eighty-seven Pounds Ten Shillings are appropriated and shall be deemed to be appropriated as from the first day of July One thousand nine hundred and twenty-six for the purposes and services expressed in the First Schedule.

4. In addition to the sum specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Passed in Council this twenty-first day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-six.
