# AN ORDINANCE

To Grant and Apply a Sum out of the Revenues of the Territory to the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and to Appropriate the Supplies Granted for such Year.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri-Preamble. tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Appropriation* short title. Ordinance, 1927-1928.
- 2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Revenues of Issue and the Territory and apply towards making good the supply application, hereby granted to His Majesty for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight the sum of One Hundred and Seventy-six Thousand Seven Hundred and Twelve Pounds Ten Shillings.

Appropriation of supplies,  $£176,712\frac{1}{2}$ .

3. All sums granted by the last preceding section of this Ordinance out of the Revenues of the Territory towards making good the supply granted His Majesty amounting to the sum of One Hundred and Seventy-six Thousand Seven Hundred and Twelve Pounds Ten Shillings are appropriated and shall be deemed to be appropriated as from the first day of July One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven for the purposes and services expressed in the First Schedule.

Advances for the purposes of the Second Schedule. 4. In addition to the sum specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Appropriation of Loan and Grant Funds, £2444.

5. The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan and Grant Funds of the Territory towards the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight the sums mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto for the purposes specified therein.

Passed in Council this fifteenth day of June, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.
