AN ORDINANCE

To Amend "The Bills of Exchange Act of 1884" (Queensland adopted).

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Bills of Short title and Exchange Ordinance, 1929.
- (2) The Bills of Exchange Act of 1884 (Queensland adopted) is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Bills of Exchange Ordinance*, 1884-1929.

Amendment of 2. Section Three of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting in the definition of "Australasia" therein immediately after the words "New Zealand," the following words "the Territory of Papua,".
