AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Criminal Code."

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1934*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Criminal Code* short title.
Amendment Ordinance, 1939.

2. Immediately after Section Four Hundred and Forty-five of the *Criminal Code* the following new Section Section 445A added to the Criminal Code.
is inserted:—

445A. Any person who unlawfully uses a motor- Unlawfully using a motor vehicle.
vehicle without the consent of the owner or of the person in lawful possession thereof is guilty of an offence and is liable upon summary conviction to imprisonment with hard labour for One year or to a fine of One hundred pounds.

3. Section Four Hundred and Fifty-seven of the *Criminal Code* is amended by omitting the word "four" Section 457 of the Criminal Code amended.
and inserting the word "five" in its stead.
