## AN ORDINANCE

Relating to Duties of Customs.

E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Short title and Tariff, 1930.

- (2) The Customs Tariff, 1922-1928, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff, 1922-1930.
- 2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance Amendment of is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance except as to anything done before the commencement of this Ordinance and except so far as relates to any arrears of duty and except so far as may be necessary for the

purpose of supporting or continuing any proceeding heretofore taken or to be taken after the commencement of this Ordinance and any article declared free of duty shall be deemed to be free in accordance with the Second Schedule as so amended.

Date from which imports are to become free.

3. Where by this Ordinance any article is declared free the article declared free of duty shall be deemed to have been free as on and from the seventeenth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty, at ten o'clock in the forenoon reckoned according to the standard time in force in the Territory of Papua and this Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation at that time.

Passed in Council this seventeenth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty.
