AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Prisons Ordinance, 1919.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Prisons Ordinance, 1930.* Short Title and citation.

(2) *The Prisons Ordinance, 1919*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Prisons Ordinance, 1919-1930.*

Employment
of Prisoners as
carriers.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding at the end of Section thirty-three thereof the following new Proviso:—

“Provided that nothing contained in this Section shall extend to the employment of native prisoners as carriers outside the limits of a prison and prisoners undergoing sentences of hard labour may be so employed without special authority.”

Commence-
ment.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-ninth day of July One thousand nine hundred and nineteen.
