AN ORDINANCE

To Provide for Travelling Allowance to the Lieutenant-Governor.

[RESERVED 10TH JULY, 1934;
ASSENTED TO 3RD OCTOBER, 1934.]^(a)

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1924*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Service* Short title.
(Lieutenant-Governor's Travelling Allowance) Ordinance, 1934.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor shall be and be deemed Travelling allowance to Lieutenant-Governor.
always to have been entitled to the travelling allowance expressed to be payable to him under Regulations 24 and 25 of the *Public Service Regulations, 1926.*

Passed in Council this tenth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the third day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.
