AN ORDINANCE

To Grant and Apply out of the Public Revenue a Sum for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance* (No. 1), 1922-1923. Short title.

2. In addition to the sums authorized by the *Appropriation Ordinance*, 1922-1923, there shall and may be issued and applied for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Ordinance £15,635 appropriated to the Service of 1922-1923.
