To Grant and Apply out of the Public Revenue a Sum for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.

E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri-Preamble. b tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. In addition to the sums authorized by the Appropriated to the priation Ordinance, 1920-1921, and the Supplementary Appropriated to the priation Ordinance (No. 1), 1920-1921, there shall and may be issued and applied for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, for the purposes set forth in the First Schedule

to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the sums in the said First Schedule respectively set forth amounting to Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-one Pounds.

Advances for the purposes of the Second Schedule. 2. In addition to the sums specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Short title.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance (No. 2), 1920-1921.
