AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1926."

[Reserved 13th June, 1927.] Assented to 7th December, 1927.] (a)

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Super-short-title and annuation Ordinance, 1927.
- (2) The Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1926, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1927.

2. After Section 16A of the Principal Ordinance the following new section is inserted:—

Superannuation allowance to be suspended in certain cases.

- "16B. (1) If any person to whom a superannuation allowance is payable under this Ordinance is appointed to any office in the Public Service of a tropical Territory of the Commonwealth then during his tenure of such office such superannuation allowance shall cease to be payable.
- (2) For the purposes of this section the term 'tropical Territory of the Commonwealth' shall include—
 - (a) the Territory of New Guinea;
 - (b) the Island of Nauru;
 - (c) that part of the Northern Territory which is now known as North Australia and is situated North of the twentieth parallel of South Latitude."
- Passed in Council this thirteenth day of June, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.
- Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the seventh day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.
