

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 11 of 1919.

Made under the *Constabulary Ordinance*, 1908-1914.

1. Regulation No. 1 (4) of the 13th December, 1909, is repealed and the following regulation is substituted therefor :—

“All recruits on enrolment, or as soon thereafter as possible, shall go through six months' training at head-quarters, Port Moresby, unless otherwise ordered by the Lieutenant-Governor or the Government Secretary.”
