STATUTORY RULES.

No. 7 of 1921.

REGULATIONS

Made under the Customs Ordinance, 1909-1916.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs Regulations, 1921.
- 2. The Regulations made under the *Customs Ordinance*, 1909-1916, on the fourth day of July, 1917, and published in the *Gazette* dated the fourteenth day of July, 1917, are amended as follows:—

By omitting therefrom Regulation 22 (1) and (2) and inserting in its stead the following:—

- "22. (1) When work is permitted during any but the prescribed hours, or on any Sunday or holiday, the rates to be charged for the services of the officers employed shall be as follows, viz.:—
 - (a) Officers of the indoor staff, 5s. 6d. per hour or part thereof.
 - (b) Officers in charge of the loading or discharge of goods on or from ships, or the delivery or receipt of goods under entry, 5s. 6d. per hour or part thereof.
 - (c) Officers acting under the direct supervision of a superior officer 2s. 9d. per hour or part thereof.
 - (d) For officers clearing vessels, 10s. 6d. for each vessel cleared.

These charges shall be calculated from the hour the officer is required to attend."
