

# STATUTORY RULES.

No. 16 of 1939.

Made under the *Customs Ordinance*, 1909-1939.

The *Customs Regulations*, 1917 (Statutory Rules No. 8 of 1917), are further amended as follows:—

1. By omitting from Regulation 107 the words “Goods imported into Papua for the purpose of being repaired, put together, or, subject to the approval of the Collector, for other industrial purposes” and inserting the following words in their stead:—

“Goods imported into Papua for the purpose of being repaired, put together, or subject to the approval of the Treasurer, of being used for or in connection with any industrial or commercial enterprise, or for any industrial, commercial, or scientific purpose;” and

2. By inserting in Paragraph (d) of the proviso to Regulation 107 immediately after the word “months” the words “or such further time as may be allowed under the provisions of the said section.”
