

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 4 of 1930.

Made under the *Health Ordinance*, 1912-1924.

The *Health (Port Moresby Sanitary) Regulations*, 1922 (Statutory Rules No. 14 of 1922), are further amended as follows:—

1. By repealing Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 13 thereof and substituting the following sub-regulation in lieu thereof:—

“(1) The charges for services for the purpose of removing, emptying and cleansing of one pan and one receptacle twice a week shall be at the rate of Six shillings per calendar month.”

2. By repealing Regulation 14 thereof and substituting the following Regulation in lieu thereof:—

“14. Charges for services shall be paid quarterly in advance and within fourteen days from the date of service of the account. Payment of such charges within the specified time of fourteen days from the service of the account therefor will entitle the person paying the same to a discount thereon calculated at the rate of Twopence in the Shilling on the total amount of the account.”
