

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 10 of 1919.

Made under *The Mining Act of 1898* (Queensland Adopted).

1. The regulations made under *The Mining Act of 1898* (Queensland adopted), on the 22nd day of June, 1900, are amended as follows:—

Regulation No. 7 is repealed and the following new regulation is inserted in lieu thereof:—

MACHINERY CONDITIONS.

“7. After the expiration of twelve months from the date of the granting of a claim, at least one dredge or other machinery approved by the Director of Mines must be on such claim, and one dredge or other machinery approved by the Director of Mines must thenceforth, unless the Warden otherwise permits, be at work on such claim on all working days. An exemption from labour conditions shall include an exemption from working dredges or other machinery approved by the Director of Mines.”
