STATUTORY RULES. No. 15 of 1929.

Made under The Mining Act of 1898 (Queensland adopted).

The Mining Regulations (Statutory Rules No. 5 of 1923), are further amended as follows:—

- 1. By inserting in Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 97 thereof immediately after the words "such marking," the following words "or within such further period as the Warden may upon application in a particular case direct,";
- 2. By adding at the end of Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 97 thereof the following new proviso:—
 - "Provided that the Warden may upon application in a particular case dispense with the posting of the true copy of the certificate as aforesaid and direct such other mode of publication in lieu thereof as he thinks fit."
- 3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of May, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
- Made in Executive Council this seventh day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
