No. 14 of 1919.

Made under the *Native Labour Ordinance*, 1911-1916.

1. The Schedule to Regulation No. 41, made under the *Native Labour Ordinance*, 1911-12, is hereby repealed and the following Schedule is substituted in lieu thereof:—

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REMOVE NATIVES FROM PORT MORESBY DISTRICT.

(Native Labour Regulation No. 41).

I, _____ hereby give notice that on or about the _____ day of _____ 19 I intend to remove the under-mentioned natives from the Port Moresby District—
(a) to their homes in the _____ Division;
(b) to work at _____ in the _____ Division
by the vessel _____ leaving Port Moresby on the afore-mentioned date.
The natives mentioned herein are at present sleeping at _____

During the past two months the said natives have been working and living only at _____ in the _____ Division.

There are no cases of sickness amongst them as far as I can see; no case of dysentery or other infectious disease has occurred amongst them during the last two months as far as I can ascertain, and no case of dysentery or other infectious disease has occurred amongst natives living at the same plantation, encampment or quarters within the last four weeks as far as I can ascertain, except—
