REGULATIONS

Made under The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908.

Regulation 70A of the regulations dealing with Native Matters under *The Native Regulation Ordinance of* 1908 is amended by the omission of (ii) of Subsection (2) and the insertion in lieu thereof of the words "labourers under contract of service under the Ordinances relating to native labour who hold written permission from their employer to wear clothes; the permission shall last for so long as is expressed therein and may be withdrawn by the employer at any time except for natives specially exempted by a Resident Magistrate or an Assistant Resident Magistrate or a Magistrate for Native Matters"; and by the addition to (iv) of Subsection (2) of the words "No exemption shall be for a longer period than twelve months, but an exemption may be renewed. An exemption may be withdrawn by a Resident or Assistant Resident Magistrate if it is being abused."

These amendments shall come into force on 1st January, 1922; no exemption already issued under Subsection 2 (iv) of Regulation 70A shall have any effect after that date.
